They are once again trying to find some dog walking help for a resident of Turvey, but do not have enough local volunteers to be able to help them, so wondered if any of the Turvey

church family might like to help Their aim is to relieve the owners of any worry concerning the welfare of their pets both during and after their own lifetime, making them unique amongst charities. All volunteers help in the ways that are most appropriate to them. Teams take it in turn to visit housebound owners, to take dogs for a walks, volunteers foster pets as one of their family when owners face a spell in hospital, they take pets to the vet, clean a budgie's cage out etc.
