In 2017, Turvey Village donated 182.36 kg of food which contributed to the foodbank being able to feed 6570 people of whom 2245 were children and to distribute 73662 kilogrammes.

We now have around 170 agencies who are ideally placed in the community to identify individuals and families who are in need and to distribute vouchers. They are working with the people so are aware of the background stories and what other help is being received.

We would like to thank everyone who contributed food, their time or money to enable this to happen.

Turvey All Saints Church is a drop off point for the village and the Food Bank box is emptied regularly.
