If you prefer watching to listening, other groups will be looking at "Finding a Voice" based on the film of the "King's Speech" which explores how we can use our own strengths to overcome difficulties. BBC Radio 3 marks Holy Week and Easter week with Choral Evensong broadcasting live from Chester Cathedral and Norwich Cathedral respectively.

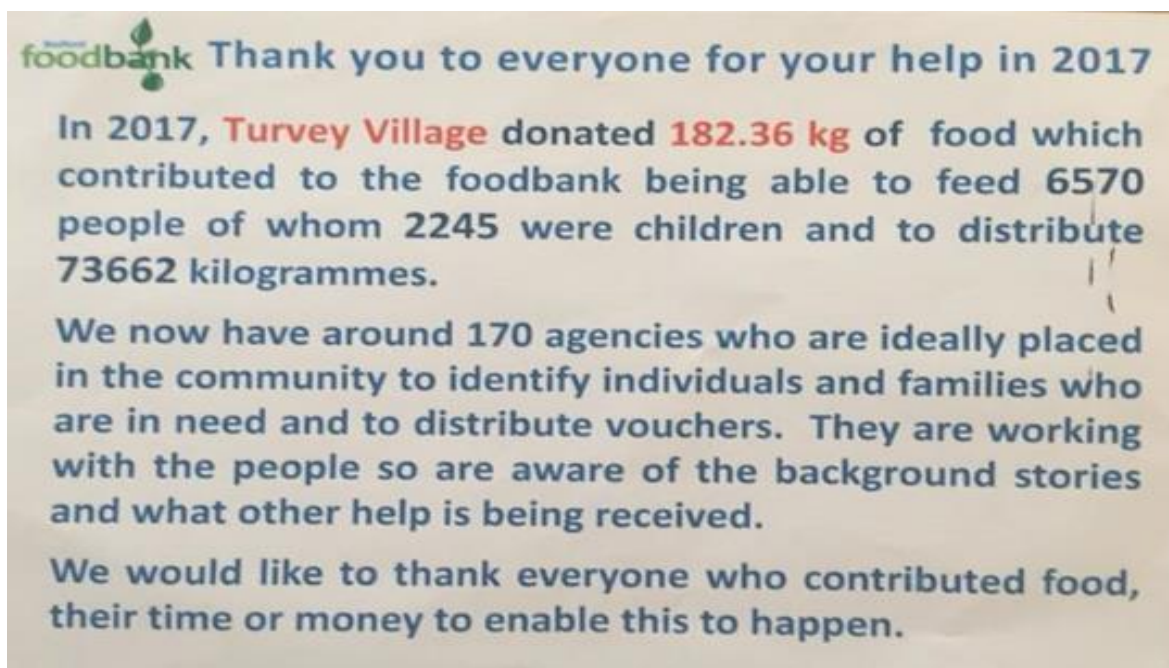
