Thy Kingdom Come: 10th -

20th May 2018 is a global prayer movement that invites Christians around the world to pray for more people to come to know Jesus. During the 11 days of Thy Kingdom Come, it is hoped that everyone who participates will deepen their friendship with Jesus, bring others to know Jesus or come to know him better, and realise also that every aspect of their life is the stuff of prayer.

Thy Kingdom Come is an invitation to pray for a focused period - between Ascension and Pentecost - 11 consecutive days - this year 10th - 20th May 2018, The commitment is to 'Pledge to Pray- by signing up on- line - individuals, families, churches.

A Beacon Celebration Event is planned for Pentecost Sunday - 20th May 2018 - to which everyone is invited to share and celebrate what has happened and prayers that have been answered in this focused period.

What happened last year? Churches from 85 countries took part. This included churches from over 50 denominations - incl. Roman Catholic, Pentecostal, Salvation Army, Methodist, Baptist, Redeemed Christian Church of God, Thy Kingdom Come materials were produced in 10 different languages, 500,000 packs of resources were sent out and every diocese in the Church of England participated.
